Revised Procedure for re-entry of Indian Nationals to Japan

As per the latest notification/guidelines issued by the concerned Japanese authorities, relating to Re-entry of foreign nationals in Japan, the holders of valid status of residence with valid re-entry permit who left Japan on or before May 26, 2020 are now allowed to re-enter Japan

All concerned Indian nationals who left Japan for India on or before May 26, 2020 may please approach the Embassy of Japan in New Delhi or their Consulates in India and apply for 'Re-Entry confirmation letter'. The procedure to apply for above permission and the terms and conditions under which this will be processed, including the applicable dates, are given in the following link of the Embassy of Japan, New Delhi:

As regards Indian nationals who departed Japan on or after May 27, 2020 and intend to return to/re-enter Japan, they need to contact the Embassy of India, Tokyo and send in their request with all related documents urgently (attcons.tokyo@mea.gov.in; fscons.tokyo@mea.gov.in; mincons.tokyo@mea.gov.in). They should also register (if not already done) by providing required details at the link <https://forms.gle/nunCVUzVKJHp1wLS6>.

It may please be noted that any permission for re-entry to Japan will be given by the concerned authorities of the Government of Japan, and that the Embassy of India, Tokyo, will only be facilitating the process.

Documents to be submitted to the Embassy for consideration of re-entry to Japan:

- a) Passport copies
- b) Copy of Residence Card
- c) Re-entry permit on the passport
- d) Special re-entry permit stamped behind the paper stapled with the passport
- e) The last immigration exit stamp
- f) Certificate of residence (Juminhyo)
- g) Reason with valid documents for Visiting India after 27th May, 2020
