## Re-entry of Indians to Japan

As per the latest notification/guidelines issued by the Japanese authorities, all foreign nationals with the status of residence, who had left Japan before August 31, 2020 with a valid re-entry permit, are now eligible to re-enter Japan from September 1, 2020.

The following are the highlights for re-entry of Indian nationals to Japan:

- Indians who left Japan on or before May 26 can return to Japan based on Re-Entry Confirmation Letter (to be issued by the Embassy of Japan in Delhi, or Japanese Consulates in India), as well as a negative PCR test 72 hours <u>prior to</u> <u>departure from India</u>;
- 2. **Indians who left Japan between May 27 and August 31** can also now return to Japan based on Re-Entry Confirmation Letter (to be issued by the Embassy of Japan in Delhi, or Japanese Consulates in India), as well as a negative PCR test 72 hours prior to departure from India;
- 3. **Indians who leave Japan from September 1 onwards** would need to get a Receipt to re-enter Japan from the Immigration Services Agency of Japan <u>before leaving Japan</u>. In addition, they would have to obtain a negative PCR test 72 hours <u>prior to departure from India</u>.
- 4. In view of these changes, there shall be no further role for the Embassy of India, Tokyo in processing any requests for re-entry by Indian citizens.
