Application procedure

About Specified Skilled Workers scheme

At the 197th Diet Session, "A bill to partially amend Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act and the Act for Establishment of the Ministry of Justice" was passed. The bill was officially announced on 14 December, 2018 and Japan started accepting foreigners with specified skills from 1st April, 2019.

In order to clarify the interpretation of laws and regulations regarding this system and points to keep in mind when operating the system, GoJ has published the "Operational Guidelines for Accepting Foreigners with Specified Skills".

Residency Applications for Foreigners with Specified Skills

Residency applications from foreign persons who wish to enter and live in Japan with the residential status of "Specified Skilled Worker" can be accepted at regional immigration offices.
