PUBLIC NOTICE

Re-issuance of International Driving Permit (IDP) by the Embassy/Consulate from 15.02.2021

Ministry of Transport and Highways (MoRTH), India has introduced a new service for re-issuance of International Driving Permit (IDP) through Embassy/Consulate to eligible Indian nationals in Japan. **The International Driving Permit (IDP)**, which is valid for **ONE YEAR only**, helps Indian Nationals drive vehicles **as per Indian Driving License** in **foreign countries** which are signatories to the Geneva Convention on Road Traffic, 1949.

2. The Mission, **w.e.f. 15.02.2021**, will accept applications for Re-issuance of International Driving Permit (IDP) to Indian Nationals who **possess relevant documents, on payment of prescribed fees (JPY 1400+ Service Charges 250)**.

3. **The procedure for Re-Issuance of *International Driving Permits (IDP)* is as follows:**

(i). Applicants should submit the Miscellaneous Service Form (https://www.indembassy-tokyo.gov.in/downloads/MISC-serv-Form_8-11-17.pdf) for Re-issuance of **International Driving Permit (IDP) to the Embassy of India, Tokyo on any working day between 0930-1130 a.m.** The applicant must possess valid Indian passport, Driving License issued by Government of India, IDP issued by the Government of India, and Japanese Resident Card in order to avail this service.

(ii) Thereafter, applicants will need to apply for **fresh issue of International Driving Permit (IDP)** through the portal www.parivahan.gov.in and will upload the documents including the **RECEIPT** issued by the Embassy, as required under the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989.

(iii) On receipt of online application, the licensing authority, after verification of the documents, shall issue the **International Driving Permit (IDP)** and courier it directly to the address of the applicant.
