<u>Remarks by Mr Sibi George, Ambassador of India to Japan at the Event</u> <u>on 'India's G20 Presidency: G20 Empower', April 25, 2023</u>

Good afternoon ladies and gentlemen.

With the G20 nations representing over 80% of the world's GDP, 75% of international trade, and 60% of the world's population, the G20 can play a vital role in delivering on women's empowerment and gender equality.

India's G20 Presidency has been committed to advancing women-led development and achieving transformative changes towards women's economic empowerment. In this regard, G20 EMPOWER, a unique alliance of business leaders and governmental representatives from G20 nations aimed at accelerating women's leadership and empowerment in the private sector, plays a crucial role in setting the agenda for achieving this objective.

We are glad to have a message from the Chair of G20 Empower India, Ms. Sangita Reddy, which will be followed by a detailed presentation on the activities of G20 Empower under India's Presidency of the G20.

India's G20 Presidency is taking significant strides to further the agenda of women empowerment, and I am confident that we can make a lasting impact towards achieving gender equality and economic prosperity.
