Ambassador's Remarks at the Japan India Parliamentary Friendship League Event on April 12, 2023

Hon'ble Chairman of JIPFL Your Excellency Mr. Hosoda, Hon'ble New Chairman Mr. Nishimura,

As we overcome the Covid 19 restrictions, what we are witnessing is a real momentum in our relationship. During the visit of Hon'ble Prime Minister Kishida to India, 2023 was declared as the India – Japan Year of Tourism with the theme 'Connecting Himalayas with Mount Fuji'. I invite you all to visit India this year and see for yourself the economic transformation that has taken place in India, in which Japan is a major partner. It is important that every member of JIPFL visits India at least once this year. Once again I wish the new leadership of JIPFL a very successful and fruitful year ahead.
